Construction prior to plan approval will incur a citation fee. An Inspection Job Card with required inspections will be provided upon the return of approved plans. Approved and stamped plans need to be on-site during the construction and inspection of systems. Neglecting required inspections will incur a citation fee, as well as the possibility of device or system alteration or additional testing. Deviation from the approved plan will require a resubmittal to the Fire Prevention Bureau.

DECLARATIONS

(Required per California Health & Safety Code, Section 19825.)

CONTRACTOR

I, hereby affirm under penalty of perjury, that I am licensed under provisions of Chapter 9, commencing with Section 7000, of Division 3, of the Business and Professions Code, and my license is in full force and effect.

OWNER/BUILDER

I, hereby affirm under penalty of perjury, that I am exempt from the Contractor's License Law for the following reason (Sec. 7031.5, Business and Professions Code). Any city or county which requires a permit to construct, alter, improve, demolish, or repair any structure, prior to its issuance also requires the applicant for such permit to file a signed statement that he or she is licensed pursuant to the provisions of the Contractor's License Law (Chapter 9, commencing with Section 7000, of Division 3, of the Business and Professions Code) or that he or she is exempt there from and the basis for the alleged exemption. Any violation of Section 7031.5 by an applicant for a permit subjects the applicant to a civil penalty of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500).

I, as owner of the property, or my employees with wages as their sole compensation, will do the work, and the structure is not intended or offered for sale (Sec. 7044, Business and Professions Code). The Contractor's License law does not apply to an owner of property who builds or improves thereon, and who does such work himself or herself or through his or her own employees, provided that such improvements are not intended or offered for sale. If however, the building or improvement is sold within one year of completion, the owner/builder will have the burden of proving that he or she did not build or improve for the purpose of sale.

I, as owner of the property, am exclusively contracting with licensed contractors to construct the project (Sec. 7044 Business and Professions Code). The Contractor's License law does not apply to an owner of property who builds or improves thereon and who contracts for such projects with a contractor(s) licensed pursuant to the Contractor's Law.

I, as owner of the property, am exempt under Sec. 7031.5, Building and Professions Code, for this reason:

WORKERS' COMPENSATION

I, hereby affirm under penalty of perjury, one of the following declarations:

I, certify that, in the performance of the work for which this permit is issued, I shall not employ any person in any manner so as to become subject to the workers' compensation laws of California, and agree that if I should become subject to the workers' compensation provisions of Section 3700 of the Labor Code, I shall forthwith comply with its provisions.

I have, and will maintain, a certificate of consent to self-insure for workers' compensation, as provided for by Section 3700 of the Labor Code, for the performance of the work for which this permit is issued.
